DESCRIPTION

Sealguard Foam is one component, water based, acrylic elastomeric, waterproof and protective coating specially formulated for applications over roof polyurethane insulation foam.

APPLICATIONS

Sealguard Foam is designed for use as a waterproof coating over roof polyurethane foam.

METHOD OF USE

APPLICATION

Sealguard Foam can be applied by brush, roll, or airless spray machine. The first coat of Sealguard Foam should be applied at the rate of 2.5 - 3.0 m²/kg and allowed to cure for 4 - 12 hours depending on ambient temperature.

For airless spray applications, Sealguard Foam can be diluted with water by up to 30%. The second coat should be applied perpendicular to the first coat at the same rate above, and allowed to cure.

For heavy pedestrian traffic, it is recommended to use fibreglass scrim reinforcement, embedded firmly in the second coat while wet, and a third coat should be applied.

Notes:

- Sealguard Foam should not be applied at ambient temperatures below 5°C and dropping.
- Sealguard Foam should not be applied on surfaces expected to suffer form rising dampness or relative humidity greater than 75%.

CLEANING

All tools should be washed and cleaned immediately after use with clean water.

PACKAGING

Sealguard Foam is available in 5 and 20 kg packs.

COVERAGE

2.5 - 3.0 m²/kg per coat.

STORAGE

Sealguard Foam has a shelf life of 12 months from date of manufacture if stored at temperatures between 5°C and 40°C .

As with all acrylic paints, care should be taken during use and storage to avoid contact with skin, eyes and mouth. Wear suitable protective clothing, gloves and eye/face protection.
